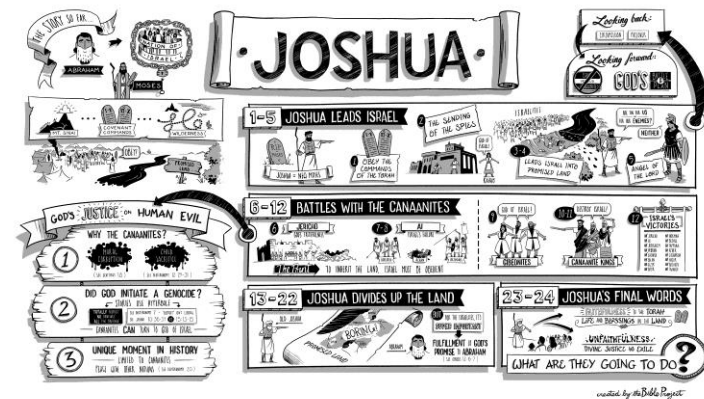
Pastor's Bible Study will be available on ZOOM for those who do not feel comfortable meeting in person.
